The Holy Face of Jesus Community for youth in the Philippines, founded by Joanne Garcia, celebrated its three-year anniversary this year.

Three missionary families are serving in locations where Christians only make up less than 5% of the population, and many have never heard the Gospel.

Field supervisors John-Paul and Ben visited three of FMC's mission posts in Asia to offer support to missionaries and to share in their ministries, prayer, and fellowship.

LATIN AMERICA

This year, our missionaries have served the poor and evangelized in remote areas of Mexico, Costa Rica, Ecuador, and Peru.

We have helped families gain sustainable income, provided shelter and assistance for mothers and children in dangerous domestic situations, aided many in medical crises, prepared children for receiving the sacraments, and opened the *Centro Verso L'alto* for youth in Peru (pictured above).



NEW FRONTIERS

In October, the Geerling family began their mission in a remote area of Trinidad. The immediate need they find there is initial evangelization. There is only one priest serving six communities spread out over 28 miles of difficult roads.

The Vehige family made an exploratory trip to the Republic of Ireland and will return there next year to labor for the re-evangelization of this country.
